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## **INTRODUCTION:**

Dhubri Medical College and Hospital is the 9<sup>th</sup> government medical College and hospital in Assam, located on RK Mission Road, Jhagarpar, Dhubri which is approximately 290 km away from Guwahati. Honourable President of India, Droupadi Murmu formally inaugurated and dedicated Dhubri Medical College and Hospital to the people of India on 13.10.2022.

The National Medical Commission (NMC) conducted the first inspection of Dhubri Medical College and Hospital on March 22 and 23, 2022 and another subsequent inspection on August 5, 2022. NMC issued Letter of Intent (LOI) on August 8, 2022 and Letter of Permission (LOP) on August 23, 2022 for admission of 100 students in the MBBS course for the session 2022-23. Currently, 100 students pursuing MBBS course as the first batch at Dhubri Medical College and Hospital. The college is affiliated to the Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences, Guwahati, Assam. It is hoped that after few years, Dhubri Medical College and Hospital will convert into a postgraduate medical institution and will produce specialist doctors.

The hospital section of Dhubri Medical College consists of a 400-bed hospital building with modern equipment, ICU, NICU, operation theatres, emergency operation theatres, emergency complex with triage area, observation ward, laboratory, blood bank, 128 slice CT scan machine, mortuary, etc. The outpatient services at Dhubri Medical College and Hospital were started on June 1, 2022 and the indoor services as well as operation services by the faculties of Dhubri Medical College and Hospital were started in July 26, 2022 at the erstwhile Dhubri Civil Hospital.
